3 AQHA/MQHA Shows Held in Two Days! Earn 3 sets of points!

Three AQHA Shows will be held in conjunction with the Futurity classes. This will be a split combined 3-judged shows and will include a full range of AQHA open and amateur classes with halter, hunter under saddle, western pleasure, horsemanship, showmanship and trail classes.

ANTE-UP CLASSES

Two Classes are offered as Ante-Up classes! You ante up and ride for \$500 added money.

Entry Fee day of the show—\$100

LIMITED RIDER NON PRO WESTERN PLEASURE

Horse must be 4 Yr Old or Older and Rider's life time earnings must be \$5,000 or less. NSBA list will be used.

OPEN HUNTER UNDER SADDLE MATURITY

Horse must be 4 Yr Old or Older

Two Judges will alternate in judging all futurity classes, with the 3rd judge being used as a tie-breaker. In the ANTE-UP Classes the total score for 3 judges will determine winners. In AQHA classes, judges will individually score classes that determines AQHA and MQHA points.
