



General Rules

- All owners and exhibitors must be current MQHA members. Membership must be paid at time of nomination. If not a current member, Membership Form and check (\$35) to MQHA should be submitted with entry.
- All Non-Pro exhibitors must hold a current AQHA Amateur card or AYQHA card. Copy must accompany entry. Relationship of exhibitor to owner must conform to AQHA rules. Hardship exception for non related Amateur/Youth exhibiting weanling in Non-Pro classes may be considered by Futurity Chair at the show.
- Five payment options are available. Photocopies of original Registration papers must be sent to the Futurity Secretary postmarked by September 1st. Original registration papers must be brought to the futurity for verification. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Change of ownership does not affect entry. However, to maintain eligibility new ownership must also meet the membership requirements or join MQHA.
- Owners may nominate any number of horses.
- No substitutions shall be made for any reason.
- Notification of any new information such as a gelded stallion, foaling date, sex, death, sale, etc should be forwarded to the Futurity Secretary by September 1st.
- AQHA rules will prevail for all issues not addressed in these Futurity Rules. Nominated horses must be eligible for registration. No carry over for HYPP H/H horses. NSBA Longe Line rules and scoring will apply for Longe Line classes. Weanling class judges will be lenient with the behavior of weanlings being shown. Weanlings will be dismissed from class only after consultation of Futurity Chair.
- Weanling Halter Classes: Back numbers must be picked up by 8:00 am on the day of show. Back #'s will clearly display foaling date. Weanlings will enter the show ring youngest (first) to oldest (last).
- Weanlings and Yearlings with "excessive white" marked on AQHA papers may be entered in Open and Non-Pro halter and yearling longe line classes. AQHA registration papers must be submitted as indicated in Rule #3
- Payback for all classes will be 100% of entry fees, late payments, added money, penalties, less expenses in the following manner: Payback will be made 33% under each of two judges and 34% of the final composite score. Payback will be made up to 10 placings or ties.
- Any owner reporting a deceased foal along with a veterinarian death certificate will be allowed to participate in the following year's futurity. All payments paid on that nomination will carry over to the following year with the exception of additional money due if payments increase. The certificate must be postmarked no later than 7 days after the death of the weanling. If this day is close to the Futurity, this death must be reported immediately by telephone and a vet certificate presented thereafter.
- Triple Challenge - Halter/Pleasure/Trail class will consist of *First*, 1 Go in Halter, *Second*, 1 Go in Western Pleasure, *Third*, 1 Go in Trail. Payout on time on composite score of the three judges on the three Go's.
- The Futurity Committee reserves the right to test for steroids and other drugs on a random basis. AQHA drug guidelines apply. NEGATIVE COGGINS REQUIRED.
