

Explanation of MQHA ALL-AROUND criteria for 2016

Points will be tallied throughout the year for the following awards:

All-around Horse
All-around Amateur Select
All-around Amateur
All-around Novice (level 1) Amateur
All-around Youth 13 and under
All-around Youth 14-18
All-around Novice Youth (level 1)
All-around Rookie
All-around Amateur Rookie
All-around Youth Rookie

Criteria for All-around Horse:

Must have minimum 10 halter points and 10 points in each of two performance classes for a total minimum of 30 points. All open classes count.

Criteria for Amateur, Select, Youth 13 & Under, and Youth 14-18 all arounds:

These awards are based on total points in each division. Halter classes count but are not required. Amateur halter counts towards both amateur and select; youth halter counts towards 13 and under and 14-18.

Criteria for Novice Amateur and Novice Youth all-around:

All novice amateur points count toward novice amateur all-around and all novice youth points count toward novice youth all-around but no halter points count since there are no novice halter classes.

Criteria for Open Rookie, Amateur Rookie, and Youth Rookie all-around:

All points in each division count but no halter points count since there are no rookie halter classes. All open rookie classes count toward Rookie all-around, all amateur rookie classes count toward amateur rookie all-around, and all youth rookie classes count towards youth rookie all-around.
