

MYQHA Meeting January 25<sup>th</sup>, 2014

The meeting was called to order at 10:12am by president Connor Crook.

Our next fundraiser will be at the April R&J show on Saturday, April 5<sup>th</sup>. The audience will bet on which horse and rider combination will win and a percentage of the winnings will go back to the rider and the highest bidder. The other money will go back to MYQHA. This fundraiser will be further discussed at our next meeting at the March Winona Show.

There will be no fundraiser at the April TQ Circuit show due to a possible cancelation of the show.

Several fundraiser will take place at the Corporate Challenge, May 23<sup>rd</sup>-26<sup>th</sup>. We will be selling our new clothing at this show, as well as doing silent auction baskets again. We will also try to get a work saddle from RS saddlery and have a raffle drawing to win this saddle. Taylor Jacobs will be contacting RS saddlery in Cannon Falls about getting a discounted saddle for this fundraiser. We will not be in charge of trail at the Corporate Challenge due to busy schedules and the many other fundraisers we have at this show.

The MQHA 4-H boot camp was also discussed. We will make more of an effort to sell our clothing at this show in order to promote our association and attract more members. The boot camp does not conflict with the YES conference this year so all members that are able to participate are encourage to do so! It was suggested that one night the youth should be in charge of playing a game of capture the flag or some kind of relay race involving all of the counties. We would also like to have a bonfire this year.

At this year's State Show on July 19<sup>th</sup> in Winona Minnesota, we will be having our trainer's calcutta again. The dates of the state show are moved this year, but we will still be continuing with this fundraiser.
